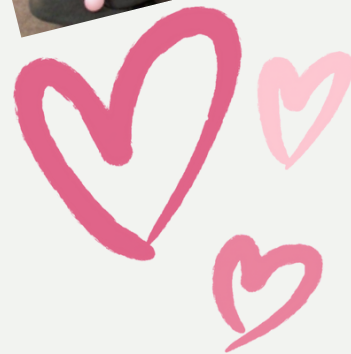


Spring term attendance winners with 96% was year 3.
