Reminders

If your child is going to be absent, please call the office 0121 556 0114 at the earliest opportunity to let us know the reason for absence. If your child is absent for 3 days or more we are required to conduct a welfare video call or home visit to ensure both yours and your child's safety and well-being.

PE KITS - Children must bring their PE kit on relevant days. If you are unable to remember what days, please send their kit in at the beginning of the week and the children can bring it home at weekends to be washed.

FOODBANKS

The cost-of-living crisis has seen foodbank distribution increase by 20% compared to last year with over 1/3 of all food throughout the year going to children. We appreciate this has impacted some of our families and we will continue to do all we can to support you through difficult times.
